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What is Tawakkul ?

1. Put in all the efforts
2. Make use of all the means
3. Rely completely on Allah for its result

Mis conception:

Tawakkul doesn't mean we leave everything and just rely on Allah.

Tawakkul actually means that we have to make use of all the means and then rely on Allah.

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One of the greatest blessing of this Tawakkul is that Allah gives us His love. Because Allah himself is saying in the Quran that Allah those people who put their trust, who rely only in Him.

We need things for our own selves in this world. And if we rely on Allah then we get Allah's loves .

When we say to Allah that we have complete Tawakkul on Him and not the means then Allah also does the same affair with us. He becomes sufficient for us.

When there is no hope still you have Tawakkul on Allah then Allah opens the doors for us.




We are believers we should not get easily depressed. Have trust in Allah.



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Benefits

1. Brings rizq. Like birds. They leave their nest empty stomach and return filled up. They make complete reliance. Every day they have this Tawakkul.
 2. Allah ﷻ gives the person a special treatment. Like in the battle of Badr, Muslim army was small, but the Beloved Prophet ﷺ spend the time to make dua to Allah and had complete Tawakkul on Allah. And as the result of this Allah sent angels for His help. The deen is the same, Allah is the same, habit of Allah doesn't change. We have changed. We do not rely on Allah the way we have to. Similarly, Maryam عليه السلام had Tawakkul on Allah and not the seasons for the fruit she is getting.
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Benefits

3. When a person puts trust in Allah, then Allah becomes sufficient for all our needs. This is unseen. We need our iman bil ghaib for this. We just make use of the efforts and means and then just rely on Allah. Allah is changer of haalaat. Allah only expects us to return back to Him.






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What if we have failed in Tawakkul ?

1. Seek forgiveness
 2. Have some level of sabr. If you are not getting something immediately have sabr and shukr on what you already have. Allah will bless us with even better than what we were expecting.
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Summary:

Don't leave the means to achieve something. However, do not rely on it. Rely Only on Allah. The means are like a puppet and strings of the puppets are in the Hands of Allah.

After doing all the hard work, just say this. That Allah this is my Mujahida. This is what I could do. But my trust and reliance is on You.

Do this for everything in life.





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Technique /Strategy

Make the habit of turning to Allah. Any effort you make, turn to Allah for a few moments and tell Allah that this is what you could do and now you rely on Him. Allah will be sufficient for you and will grant you His love.
