



2. It Requires time and effort and consistent hard work:

Once a Nobel prize winner was asked how he got this prize. He said that he worked hard consistently. Our situation unfortunately is that we don't put in the hard work. The way we look at a best job is where we don't have to work hard. This is the irony.





In this research they came to the conclusion that 10,000 hours of active consistent efforts. So let's say we want to be excellent in our deen, then we put 2 hours to do our ibadah like adhkaar, salah, salawat etc. everyday, then to achieve this 10,000 hours we have to work like this consistently for 13-14 years.

Abdullah bin Mubarak RAH studied the science of ahadith from 4000 teachers. And He would travel to get this ilm. And as a result of this he got the status of "Ameerul Mumineen of the sciences of hadith".





Hadith: The Beloved Prophet said "Allah loves consistent good deeds, even if they are little."

The best example of excellence is our Beloved Prophet . He had the excellent life. Excellent in every aspect of His life. Other human beings when they wanted to achieve excellence, they couldn't achieve it completely.

He worked hard, consistently in every aspect of His life, all through His life.





# 3. Loving Mentor

If in one field 10,000 hours are required for excellence. Then why only a few people are able to give these many hours and others cannot? The research came up with the result, that those kids who excelled growing up, they had a loving teacher. They developed the love for that field because of the love and respect for that teacher.
